HOW TO GET STARTED

- Each MHS Class will pick their Homecoming Float theme. Themes should be approved by the Class Sponsor.
- Each MHS Class should put together a list of supplies needed and submit to the Class Sponsor.
- The Class Sponsor will submit the PO to the school to secure funding for the float supplies.
- The Class Sponsor will be responsible for purchasing the float supplies.
- The Madill Alumni Association will be on site to chaperone while floats are being built. Joe Williams, local artist, has once again agreed to graciously share his talent and will be available to help all classes bring their ideas to life.

GUIDELINES

- Keep it clean. Floats displaying inappropriate or negative messages will not be allowed.
- Due to a space constraint, trailers can be no longer than 16ft. Additionally, ONLY adults with trailer-backing experience should maneuver trailers within the building.
- The City Annex houses City property. Anyone caught tampering with City property will receive a citation with a \$260 fine and be trespassed from all city property, including parks, cemetery, swimming pool, fitness center, public library, and other municipal facilities. Security cameras will be in use.
- NO spray painting inside the building.
