It is our intent that this letter serves as an explanation for the scholarship application process.

1. Complete the application. This is a fillable PDF form that is very easy to complete. Fill this out with as much information as possible.
2. Attach a résumé. This should be a simple résumé outlining your activities, accomplishments, awards, work experience, etc. This is simply an easy, concise way to organize information in one place. We have provided a sample résumé as an example of how to build one (the Microsoft Word templates are a great way to start).
3. Attach a copy of your official transcript dated 2026.
4. Attach a recent photo.

Once completed, you may submit your application on the same webpage where you downloaded this application. Scroll to the bottom to submit. You will receive a confirmation email once you submit. Check your junk/spam folder!

5. Meet & Greet. Once the deadline has lapsed, an email will be sent to each applicant with a link to sign up for our “Meet & Greet” event. This event is an informal opportunity for the scholarship committee to meet with scholarship applicants one-on-one about applicants’ future aspirations, interests, etc. A virtual option will be available for non-local applicants.
6. Banquet. Attend the Annual Madill Alumni Banquet where all scholarships will be awarded. The 2026 Madill Alumni Banquet is scheduled for Saturday, May 16, 2026 at 6pm. Scholarships will **NOT** be awarded to applicants not in attendance.
