

MADILL HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

The scholarship committee of the Madill Alumni Educational Foundation is excited to offer multiple scholarships to Madill graduates. As alumni, we are very proud of Madill students and are excited to assist graduates in their post-high school careers. It is our intent that this letter serves as an explanation of the scholarship application process. All steps numerated below are required for your scholarship application to be considered complete.

1. Complete the application. This is a fillable PDF form that is very easy to complete. Fill this out with as much information as possible.
2. Attach a résumé. This should be a simple résumé outlining your activities, accomplishments, awards, work experience, etc. This is simply an easy, concise way to put four years of activities in one place. We have provided a sample résumé as an example of how to build one (the Microsoft Word templates are a great way to start).
3. Attach your FAFSA printable report or your FAFSA opt-out form.
4. Attach a copy of your official MHS transcript dated 2026.
5. Attach a copy of your Senior panel photo or another recent photo.
6. Meet & Greet. Once the application deadline has lapsed, an email will be sent to each applicant with a link to sign up for our “Meet & Greet” event. This event is an informal opportunity for the scholarship committee to meet with scholarship applicants one-on-one about applicants’ future aspirations, interests, etc. The Meet & Greet sessions will be held in the MHS Library in late April and will be no more than 5-10 minutes per applicant.
7. Banquet. Attend the Annual Madill Alumni Banquet where all scholarships will be awarded. The 2026 Madill Alumni Banquet is scheduled for Saturday, May 16, 2026 at 6pm. Scholarships will **NOT** be awarded to applicants not in attendance.

ALL STEPS ARE REQUIRED TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ANY OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

It is our hope that this new process will be less stressful for applicants and more personal for the scholarship committee.
